Our charity has offered free services in all twelve inner London Boroughs for 187 years. BlindAid supports a particularly hidden group of beneficiaries- isolated, blind and visually impaired people. Our free services focus on wellbeing, confidence and expanding social networks. Our Sight Support Service provides vital, outreach support for 1300 people a year.

Our Community Projects offer 16 week courses in IT, cooking and healthy eating, yoga, art and creative writing. We also run local coffee events, social outings and a grants programme- providing items that support independent living.

We have had the pleasure of working with IntrasonusUK and Sandrine Monin on a few external creative projects, which have been greatly beneficial to our beneficiaries.
